- Mr. Carrillo, soccer coach, about 50 players for both boys and girls soccer team. Would like to do an end of the year celebration. Have the biggest team. Mr. Carillo would like to request \$200 for both teams for a celebration, pizza, drinks. Celeste motions to not exceed \$350 to purchase end of season celebration for the boys and girls soccer team. Ms. Ortegon seconds. All voted in favor. Motion passed.
- Celeste motion to not exceed \$1500 for a staff vs. student soccer game for ice cream. Arlene seconds. All voted in favor. Motion passed.
- Ms. Ortegon mentioned they are trying to open a new club called Mustang Patrol with Mr. Ernie. Ms. Ortegon requested for PTSO to purchase vest that say "Mustangs on Patrol." Ms. Ortegon will get estimates, will do a pilot program with 10 students. Nora motioned to not exceed \$100 to purchase vest and decal supplies "Mustangs on Patrol." Celeste seconds motion. All voted in favor. Motion passed.
