BUDGET (TREASURER UPDATES)

- Jonna Valdez requested \$50 for replacing sand for her Zen garden. Richard offered to donate regular sand, Joanna appreciated the gesture but expressed they need a thinner sand. Celeste motions to not exceed \$60 for items (Sand) for Zen garden. Vickey 2nd motion. Motion passed.
- Naomi Davis is requesting \$273.67 for 12 paints for ceramic paint for pottery. Reaching the last ceramic unit. Amount requesting will get us through the end of the school year. Naomi motions to fund \$273.67 for ceramic paint. Jacque seconds motion. Motion passed.

- Nick Davis-Hall requesting \$40-\$80 for trifold for students to do end of the year science project. Need 12, \$37.99 on amazon for 12. Celeste motion to not exceed \$45 for trifolds. Pete seconds motion. Motion passed
