REPORT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staffing: Three jobs are posted: P.E., Spanish, and ½ time Office Assistant. We have 5 long-term subs as we await the hire of P.E. teacher, Spanish Teacher, and the arrival/start date of 2 international hires. One is doing student teaching while she is long-term substitute. PTSO is up and running. They are planning three fundraisers to support PTSO. Weekly Snack Bar, Penny Wars to Support Fall Festival and Mrs. Fields Cookie Dough to support our school. Fall Festival is set for November 15th. Pueblo is not offering 0-hour high school Algebra; we are working to enroll students asynchronously in Algebra 1 in TUVa. We are going to offer this as a learning space. We will need funding to support this.

Quarterly Benchmarks are currently being completed for grades 2nd through 8th grade. MTSS has been meeting Monday and Friday afternoon's and have reviewed IReady data and how to use for personalized instruction. We have been working with School Safety to create a reporting document for our school that will send data to us as another avenue to address security concerns.
